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Half width rack mounting (1RU 9.5")

- 1. Connect both rack ears [79161 in diagram] to the three M3 holes located along each side of the product using the panhead screws provided ensuring they are tightened securely (6 total).
- 2. Pass your rack mount bolts through all four forward facing holes [R3 in diagram] to secure in a standard 9.5" rack.

Warnings

- Rack mounting screws are not supplied by ENTTEC. The installer is responsible for the rack fixing method. The selected method must be rated to support the total weight of product, mounting accessories and cabling attached.
- To avoid rotational stress on the device and mounting hardware, do not exert excessive stress on cabling or use the device to support other hardware.
- Do not overtighten any bolts or fixings. Overtightening could cause damage.

Full width rack mounting (1RU 19")

- 1. Connect both rack ears [79161 in diagram] to the two M3 holes located along each side of the product using the panhead screws provided ensuring they are tightened securely (4 total).
- 2. Pass your rack mount bolts through all four forward facing holes [R3 in diagram] to secure in a standard 19" rack.

- Rack mounting screws are not supplied by ENTTEC. The installer is responsible for the rack fixing method. The selected method must be rated to support the total weight of product, mounting accessories and cabling attached.
- To avoid rotational stress on the device and mounting hardware, do not exert excessive stress on cabling or use the device to support other hardware.
- Do not overtighten any bolts or fixings. Overtightening could cause damage.

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Surface mounting

- 1. Attach both angle brackets [79162 in diagram] to the M3 holes located along the bottom edge of the device using the 4 pan-head screws provided. Ensure the brackets are angled away from the device.
- 2. Hold the device up to the surface you want to attach it to and mark the location of each M5 hole using a pencil.
- 3. Remove the product from the surface, protect from dust & swarf, then create a pilot hole for your bolt or screw mounting method on each pencil mark.
- 4. Attach the device to the surface using bolts or screws rated to hold up to 5 times the weight of the device, fixing methods and cabling.

Warnings

- Fixing screws are not supplied by ENTTEC. The installer is responsible for the fixing method.
- If installing this device to a surface, ensure there are no cables, pipes or other services behind that could be damaged.
- If installing on a vertical surface or overhead, ensure your mounting solution is capable of holding 5 times the of product, mounting accessories and attached cabling.
- Only attach this bracket to flat surfaces uneven surfaces could result in pressure being applied to the underside of the device and cause damage if your surface is uneven, use spacers to ensure the device is level and only the brackets contact the surface.
- Do not modify the bracket or use it in a method not covered in this guide, doing so will void the warranty.
- Do not overtighten any bolts or fixings. Overtightening could cause damage.

DIN rail mounting (TS-35)

- 1. Attach the two TS35 DIN mount clips to both angled brackets [79162 in diagram] using the 4 countersunk screws to ensure a tight fit.
- 2. Position the brackets under the device to minimize the overall footprint. Use four pan-head screws to attach both brackets to the lower edges of the device using the M3 holes.
- 3. For best practice your TS35 DIN rail should always be connected to electrical earth.

Warnings

- Ensure your DIN rail is capable of supporting at least 5 times the weight of product, mounting accessories and attached cabling.
- Do not overtighten any bolts or fixings. Overtightening could cause damage.
